Hamamelis virginiana is a small deciduous tree with yellow flowers that is native to the eastern parts of North America. Native Americans used witch hazel for wound healing and eye problems. The ointment has shown good effects on skin injuries and topical inflammation. It is also used as an astringent, which is helpful in the treatment of acne. It is commonly found in skin care products for cleansing skin due to its antibacterial properties.



Uses of Witch Hazel

- Some people apply witch hazel directly to the skin for itching, pain and swelling (inflammation), eye inflammation, skin injury, mucous membrane inflammation, vaginal dryness after menopause, varicose veins, hemorrhoids, bruises, insect bites, minor burns, acne, sensitive scalp, and other skin irritations.
- In manufacturing, witch hazel leaf extract, bark extract, and witch hazel water are used as astringents to **tighten the skin**. They are also included in some medications to give those products the ability to **slow down or stop bleeding**. Those medications are used for **treating insect bites**, **stings**, **teething**, **hemorrhoids**, **itching**, **irritations**, and **minor pain**.




Skin benefits

It may be especially soothing if a person mixes witch hazel with aloevera, which is another plant and anti-inflammatory agent.


Rashes

Witch hazel may help soothe rashes on the skin, as it reduces inflammation.

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










As a result of various antioxidant tests, it was confirmed that Flexidermis has excellent antioxidant efficacy.












L-DOPA Oxidation Inhibition Activity (in tubo)






The elastin tissue imparts elasticity to the skin and degradation of elastin is one of the causes to wrinkle formation. Flexidermis showed anti-wrinkle efficacy by inhibiting elastase activity.








Human hair growth has a unique repetitive cycle composed of the anagen, catagen, telogen phases, and early anagen. Furthermore in this hair growth, Human Dermal Papilla (HDP) cells play a critical role in regulating hair follicle development and period regeneration. Therefore, this cycle clearly shows the importance of hair cell regeneration, which is the fundamental method to restore lost hair cells. Flexidermis was shown to have excellent hair-growth efficacy by increasing hair cells to 88.4%.










Intracellular Ca²⁺ influx was found to be transiently increased by DPM, and Flexidermis regulated Ca²⁺ influx in human keratinocytes. Flexidermis has an anti-pollution effect by inhibiting Ca²⁺ influx.


Human bronchial smooth muscle cells (HBT-SM)






Human Epidermal Keratinocytes (HaCaT)








Flexidermis was also shown to have excellent anti-microbial efficacy. According to our test, when treating 10% Flexidermis in the media, it was found to effectively inhibit the growth activity of *Staphylococcus aureus* and *Escherichia coli* by 93.5% and 50.0%, respectively.
