Plant Story

- Ocimum Basilicum is a member of the large and diverse mint family. It is a fragrant aromatic annual or biennial, which flowers in late summer (August – September).
- It typically grows to roughly 50 cm tall with clustered white/lilac flowers and abundant green leaves.
- Thought to be native to India, basil grows in the tropics, as well as in the subtropics in warm temperate area.
- In Europe, Basil is a popular culinary ingredient due to its distinctive aroma and flavour. The dried leaves are thought to be less aromatic.





Harvesting Royasil

- Basil can be harvested after 70 110 days from germination/ within the growing period.
- The harvest should take place prior to flowering with cutting possible every 60 days, up to three times after first cut.




Basil Uses

- Commonly used in cooking for flavouring and the leaves can even be used to create a tea.
- Used to alleviate issues with the digestive system/ nervous system, such as, indigestion.
- In essential oil form, it is thought to act as an insect repellant.
- In our experiments, Basil showed good effects for skin brightening and anti-wrinkle efficacies. In addition to this, it showed strong antioxidant activity.
- Other literature has confirmed these effects and shown Basil has been used to treat atopic dermatitis and other skin conditions.





Our skin is under attack from many factors in daily life, such as UV, pollution and smoking. These factors increase the Reactive Oxygen Species (ROS).





This test confirms Royasil's potential as an antioxidant with almost linear growth in DPPH scavenging activity between extract concentrations of 1.56% and 13%. There is double the activity between 6.3% and 13% and close to 90% scavenging activity at 25% concentration.


Skin Ageing and Wrinkle Formation



Skin changes with increasing age due to both intrinsic and extrinsic factors. Intrinsic skin aging is determined by genetic factors, hormonal status and metabolic reactions such as oxidative stress. One of the most important extrinsic skin aging factors is induced by UV radiation by sun exposure, referred to as photoaging. Smoking cigarettes and environmental pollution are also essential factors in premature skin aging and wrinkle formation.




Anti-wrinkle Mechanism






Mechanism of Collagen Synthesis





In vitro Efficacy Effects: Anti-wrinkle



Elastase inhibition is a measure showing the anti-aging/ anti-wrinkle properties of Royasil and with the increase of Royasil extract concentration, an increase in elastase inhibition can be seen. There is also a linear increase in inhibition from 25% to 100% extract concentration.
